Sharia (/ ʃ ə r i ə /), Sharia law, or Islamic law (Arabic: شريعة [ʃaʔriʔa]) is a religious law forming part of the Islamic tradition. It is derived from the religious precepts of Islam, particularly the Quran and the Hadith. In Arabic, the term sharʔah refers to God's immutable divine law and is contrasted with fiqh, which refers to its human scholarly interpretations. Law is a system of rules that are created and enforced through social or governmental institutions to regulate behavior. It has been defined both as "the Science of Justice" and "the Art of Justice".
